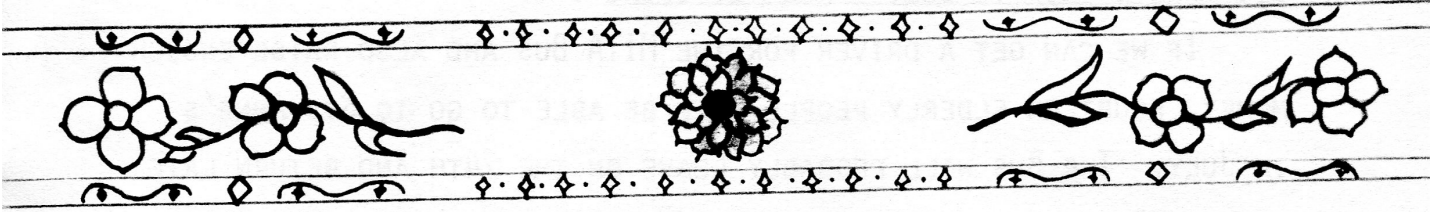

A FILM OF CAMPOBELLO AND IT'S WILD LIFE WILL ALSO BE VIEWED. LUNCH WILL BE ENJOYED AT ONE OF THE LOCAL RESTAURANTS.

FLYERS WERE SENT OUT ON MAY 21 AND 22 TO NOTIFY PEOPLE OF THE TRIP. AS OF THIS DATE WE HAVE REACHED OUR MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PEOPLE FOR INDIAN TOWNSHIP'S SHARE. PLEASANT POINTERS SHOULD CALL SOON!

SECOND TITLE VI QUARTERLY WORKSHOP IN THE WORKS

ALTHOUGH DEFINITE PLANS HAVE NOT BEEN MADE YET, WE ARE HOPING TO HAVE OUR SECOND WORKSHOP ON JUNE 30TH. IT'S TOWNSHIP'S TURN TO HAVE THE WORKSHOP THERE. WE WILL BE BASICALLY HAVING THE SAME KIND OF WORKSHOP, BUT WE'LL HAVE DIFFERENT SPEAKERS AND TOPICS.

PLEASANT POINT ELDERS WILL TRAVEL TO TOWNSHIP BY MITA BUS. IF YOU PLAN TO ATTEND, CALL NANCY OR CYRIL TO SIGN UP. REMEMBER THE BUS ONLY HOLDS FOURTEEN PEOPLE, SO CALL EARLY.

TOWNSHIP ELDERS SHOULD CALL PHYLLIS. WE NEED TO KNOW HOW MANY ARE COMING SO WE CAN HAVE ENOUGH FOOD PREPARED. FLYERS WILL BE SENT OUT AS SOON AS A DEFINITE TIME HAS BEEN SET. SEE YOU THERE!

ST. ANNE'S TRIP IN JULY - ARE YOU GOING?

IF WE CAN GET A DRIVER FOR THE MITA BUS AND ALSO RAISE ENOUGH MONEY, FOURTEEN ELDERLY PEOPLE WILL BE ABLE TO GO TO ST. ANNE'S IN JULY. THE BUS WILL PROBABLY LEAVE ON THE 24TH AND RETURN LATE ON THE 26TH, AFTER THE FESTIVITIES.

YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR YOUR OWN MEALS AND LODGING. THE TITLE 6 PROGRAM CAN ONLY PAY FOR SOME OF THE COSTS FOR GAS, OIL, ETC. THAT'S WHY WE HAVE TO ALSO RAISE MONEY TO HELP PAY FOR THE EXPENSES.

IF YOU SERIOUSLY WANT TO GO, LEAVE YOUR NAME WITH ONE OF THE TITLE 6 STAFF PEOPLE (CYRIL, PHYLLIS OR NANCY) BY THE FIRST WEEK OF JULY. I HOPE THERE ARE ENOUGH PEOPLE GOING TO JUSTIFY THE USE OF THE MITA BUS AND SO THAT ALL OF OUR EFFORTS (BOTH STAFF AND THE ELDERLY WHO ARE RAISING MONEY) WILL NOT BE WASTED. PLEASE LET US KNOW EARLY IF YOU WANT TO GO ON THE BUS.

TITLE 6 NUTRITION SERVICE AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

MEALS FOR THE ELDERLY ARE SERVED EACH MONDAY, TUESDAY AND THURSDAY FROM 11:30 AM TO 12:00 PM. ELDERS CAN GET A MEAL ON WEDNESDAY THROUGH THE CFNP PROGRAM WHICH FEEDS RECOVERING ALCOHOLICS ALSO.

ON MONDAYS AT THE MEALSITE A BEANO IS HELD FOR THE ELDERLY BY THE TITLE 6 STAFF. COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS AND SOME OF THE ELDERLY THEMSELVES HOLD A SECOND BEANO ON WEDNESDAYS. TEN PERCENT OF EACH COVERALL IS STILL DONATED TO THE FUND FOR THE ST. ANNE'S TRIP.

THIS COUNCIL MEETS ON THE LAST FRIDAY OF EACH MONTH (WHEN IT FALLS ON A HOLIDAY, THEY MEET ON THE FOLLOWING WORK DAY). MEETINGS BEGIN AT 1:00 O'CLOCK AND END AT 2:00 O'CLOCK. PLANS ARE UNDERWAY TO HOLD A BAKE SALE FOR THE TRIP TO ST. ANNE'S. OTHER ELDERS AND COMMUNITY PEOPLE WILL BE ASKED TO DONATE A CAKE OR OTHER BAKERY ITEM. ALSO IF ANY OF YOU WISH TO DONATE SOMETHING FOR A RAFFLE, PLEASE TELL DAVID FRANCIS (CHAIRMAN) OR SIMON SOCTOMAH (VICE-CHAIRMAN). WE'D LIKE TO HOLD A RAFFLE TO RAISE ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR THE TRIP.

THE COUNCIL (BOTH OF THEM) WILL BE MEETING TOGETHER AT THE NEXT QUARTERLY WORKSHOP. THEY WILL ALSO BE SEPARATELY REVIEWING NEXT YEAR'S PLAN FOR THE TITLE 6 PROGRAM WHICH HAS TO BE SENT TO WASHINGTON BEFORE JUNE 30TH.

NUTRITION SERVICE

PRESENTLY, 17 MEALS ARE HOME DELIVERED TO PLEASANT POINT ELDERS WHO ARE ON SPECIAL DIETS OR DO NOT ATTEND THE MEALS FOR ME PROGRAM. WE'RE OPERATING AT THE MAXIMUM LEVEL, BUT IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN GETTING A HOME DELIVERED MEAL YOUR NAME CAN BE PUT ON A WAITING LIST FOR FUTURE OPENINGS.

I & R, INFORMATION AND REFERRAL

NANCY AND DORIS KIRBY (AT THE HEALTH CENTER) ARE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST YOU WITH PROBLEMS YOU MAY BE HAVING WITH YOUR ELDERLY BENEFITS OR RIGHTS. IF WE CAN'T HELP, WE CAN HELP YOU FIND SOMEONE WHO WILL. DON'T HESITATE TO CALL OR SEND SOMEONE OVER TO OUR OFFICE TO LET US KNOW YOU NEED HELP.

FROM A HANDYMAN TO ASH AND BEADS

MOST OF THOSE WHO WERE TOLD THAT THEY ARE ELIGIBLE FOR TITLE 6 HANDYMAN SERVICES HAVE CALLED THE OFFICE TO START RECEIVING THIS HELP IN SMALL HOME REPAIRS. IF YOU HAVEN'T DONE SO, PLEASE CALL SOON. SUMMER IS A GOOD TIME TO GET THIS KIND OF WORK COMPLETED.

ASH, SWEETGRASS AND BEADS ARE STILL AVAILABLE TO YOU AT A LOW COST. IF YOU WANT TO DO BEADWORK OR MAKE BASKETS, WE CAN PROVIDE THE MATERIALS YOU NEED. THE ONLY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT IS THAT YOU ARE AN ELDERLY PERSON, AGED 60 AND OVER.

WE'RE HOPING TO BE ABLE TO PAY A MODEST WAGE TO THE TEACHERS. IF YOU'D LIKE TO TEACH, I'D REALLY LIKE TO TALK WITH YOU SO PLEASE CALL ME, NANCY, AT THE HEALTH CENTER (MONDAY, TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY OR FRIDAY). I'M AT TOWNSHIP ON THURSDAYS AND CAN BE REACHED AT PHYLLIS'S OFFICE.

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN LEARNING FANCY BASKETMAKING ???

WE'RE STILL TAKING NAMES OF PEOPLE AT BOTH RESERVATIONS WHO ARE INTERESTED (COMMITTED) IN LEARNING THE ART OF BASKETMAKING. WE MAY HAVE TO CHARGE A SMALL FEE TO HELP PAY THE TEACHERS. CLASSES WOULD BE IN THE EVENING DURING JULY AND/OR AUGUST. THE SCHEDULE WILL DEPEND ON THE TEACHER. LEAVE YOUR NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER WITH YOUR TITLE 6 STAFF PERSON.
